HOW TO CONSERVE WATER:

- Eat Less Water-Intensive Foods
- Our diets account for roughly half of all the water we use.
- All food has a water footprint, but some are much larger than others.
- Eating less beef, one of the most water-intensive foods, is a smart place to start.
- Shifting away from animal products to a plant-based diet can shrink your water footprint significantly.
- Remember, vegetables and fruits can be rinsed in a bowl of water to conserve water which then can be used to water plants
- Using your kitchen sprayer also reduces water usage.
- The Water Project website has many more tips for stewardship of our disappearing precious resource.
